

MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

Purpose

The Member Code of Conduct clarifies the standard of behaviour expected from each u3a member and is relevant to all members.

Member Code of Conduct

- Members must always act in the best interests of West Wolds u3a and the u3a Movement, strive to uphold its reputation and never do anything which could bring their own, another u3a member, another u3a or the u3a Movement into disrepute or expose it to undue risk.
- Members are expected to use West Wolds u3a's resources responsibly and use them only to further its stated charitable objects/purposes.
- Members are expected to respect the current organisational policy of West Wolds u3a, regardless of whether it conflicts with their personal views.
- Members are expected to abide by West Wolds u3a's procedures and practices.
- Members are expected to treat each other with dignity and respect at all times.
